3.3 Operating Modes of EUT and Determination of Worst Case Operating Mode

1. The EUT is consumes power from PC which designed with AC power of rating 100-240Vac, 50/60Hz. For radiated emission evaluation, 230Vac/50Hz (EN 50121-3-2), 120Vac/60Hz (for FCC Part 15) had been covered during the pre-test. The worst data was found at **230Vac/50Hz** and recorded in the applied test report.

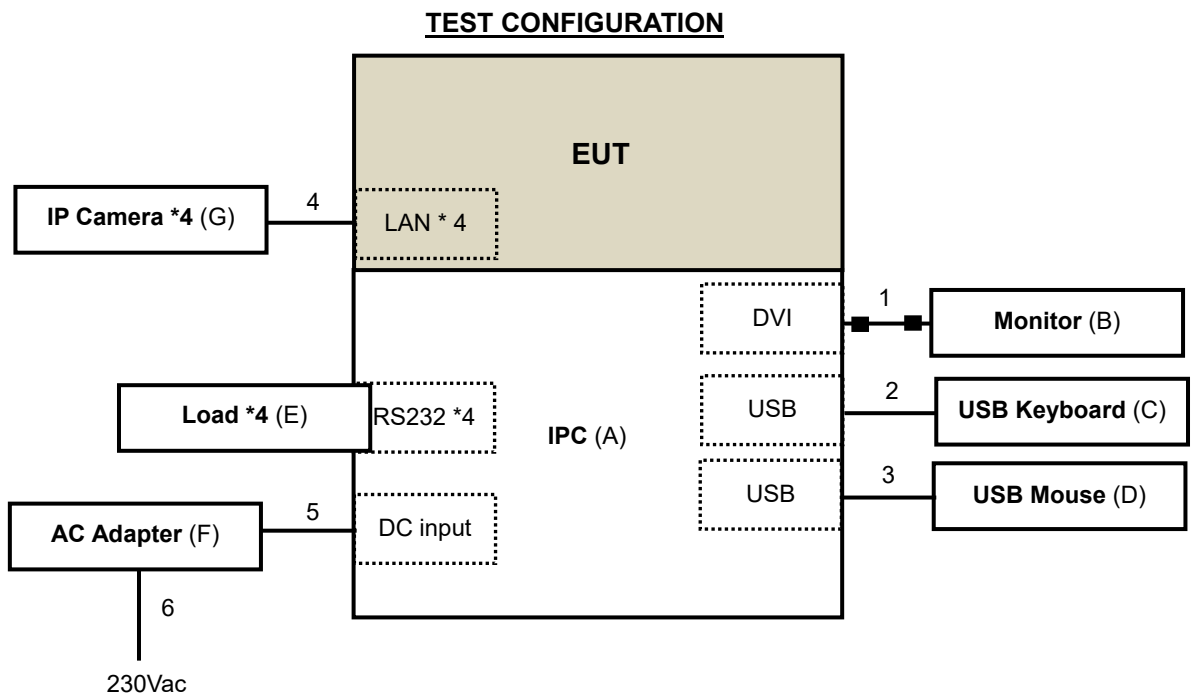

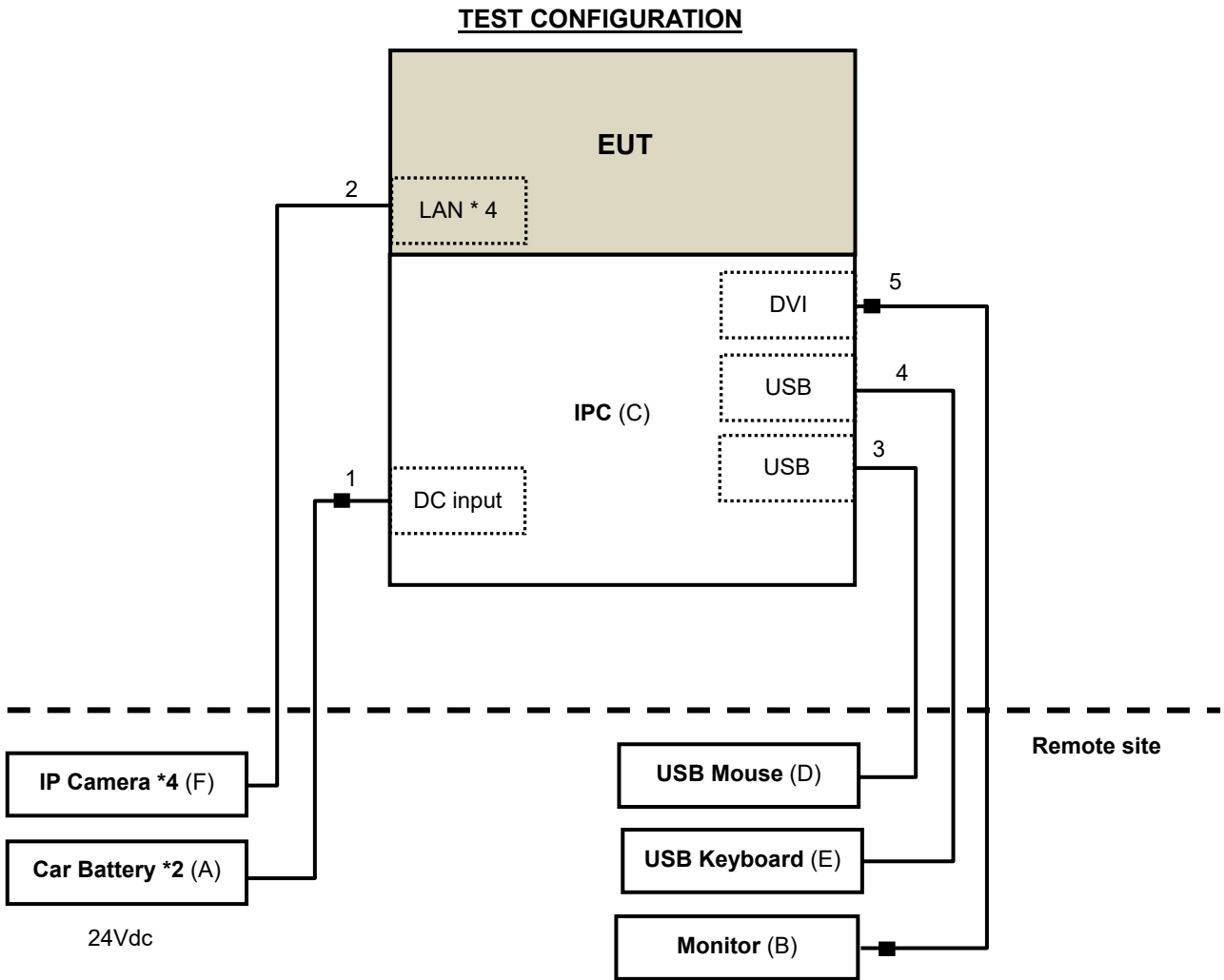

5.3 Test Arrangement

- The EUT was placed 0.4 meters from the conducting wall of the shielded room with EUT being connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). Other support units were connected to the power mains through another LISN. The two LISNs provide 50 Ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- Both lines of the power mains connected to the EUT were checked for maximum conducted interference.
- The test results of conducted emissions at mains ports are recorded of six worst margins for quasi-peak (mandatory) [and average (if necessary)] values against the limits at frequencies of interest unless the margin is 20 dB or greater.

Note: The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver is 9kHz for quasi-peak detection (QP) and average detection (AV) at frequency 0.15MHz-30MHz.

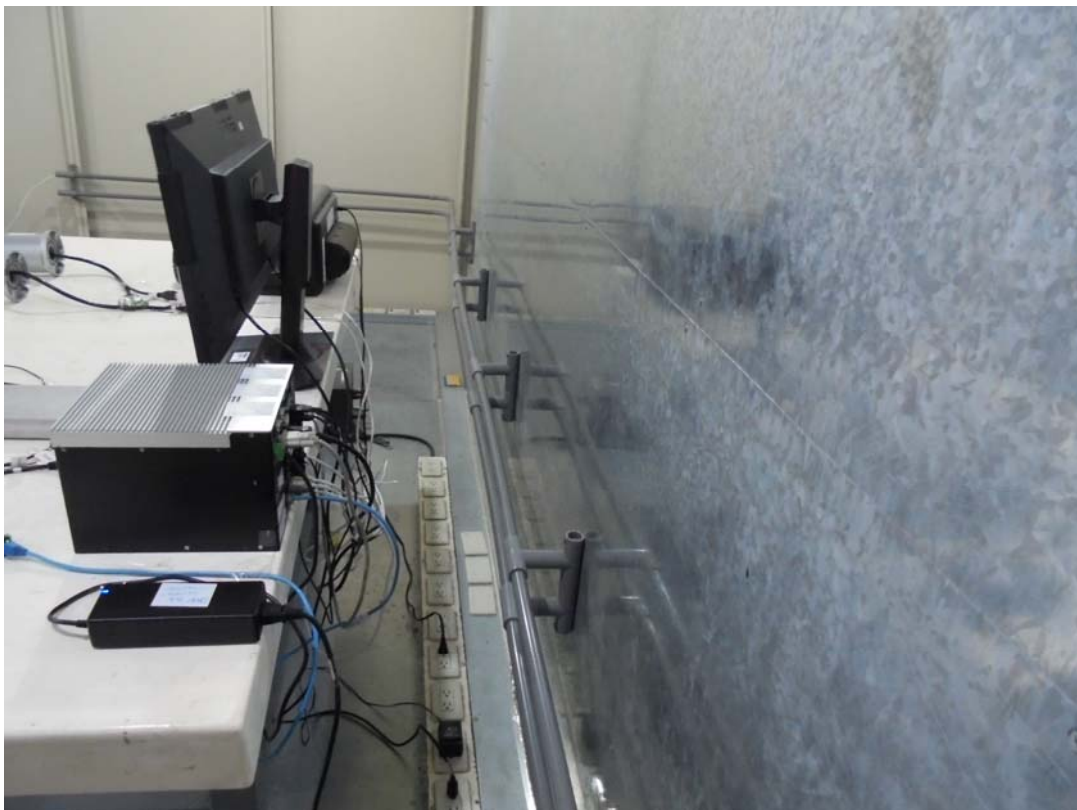

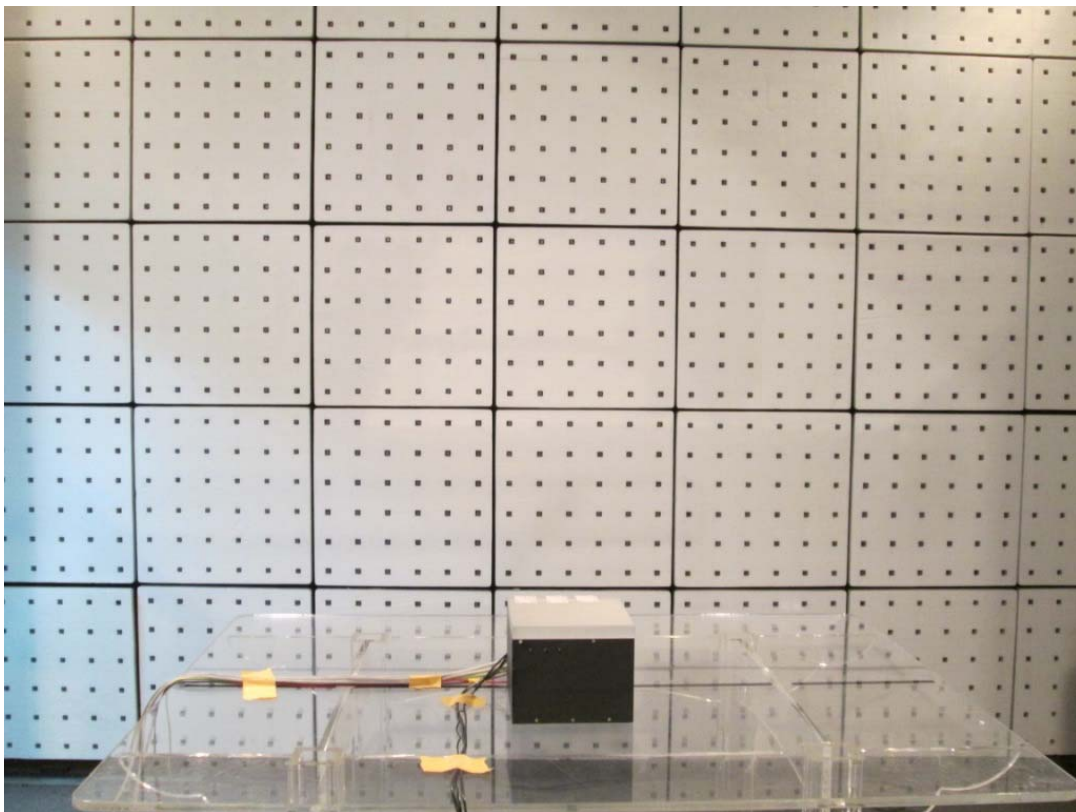
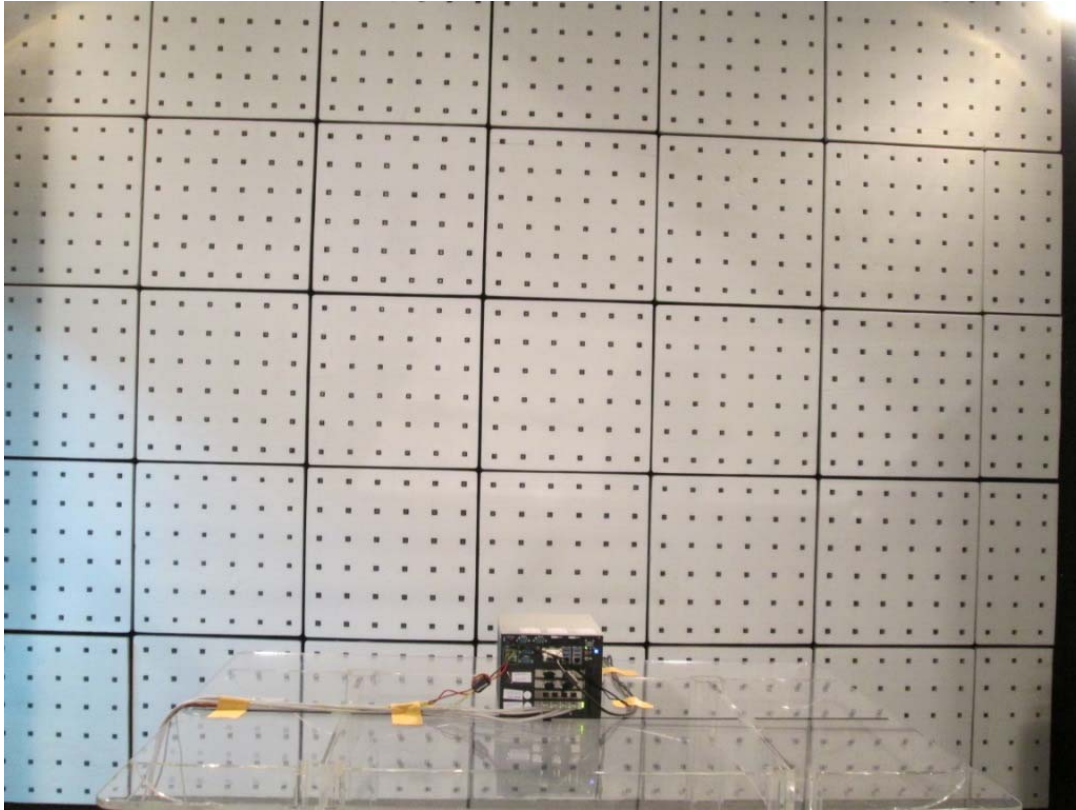
